## Description

Like a dress in the updraft above an underground shaft, the eNormaJeane by Lichtlauf floats above the table and sends powerful, soft light downwards. Copper, the colour contrast between the top and bottom creates the tension. Each lamp, individually shaped by hand, is unique. The eNormaJeane by Lichtlauf is used wherever larger, long tables are to be complemented with a light sculpture. The lampshade made of aluminium is available in brown-black or white on the upper side. The underside of the lampshade is hand-applied with copper leaf metal or in white. The three integrated LEDs with a power of 12 watts each have a colour temperature of 3,000 Kelvin warm white. The light of the integrated LEDs of this dimmable lamp is characterised by a very good colour rendering with a high colour rendering index of Ra 90. The lampshade of the eNormaJeane is 160 cm long, 30 cm wide and approx. 12 cm high. Due to the handcrafted manufacturing process, there may be irregularities in the leaf-finished surface. The total height of the lamp is max. 200 cm, the rectangular ceiling suspension is 110 cm long, 5 cm wide and 3 cm high. The height of the eNormaJeane 160 is adjusted directly on the three wire ropes with which the lamp is suspended from the ceiling. The eNormaJeane 160 by Lichtlauf is also available with a 125 cm long lampshade.
